Dear authors of the accepted abstracts:

We are delighted to invite all of you to submit manuscripts for publication in the Proceedings titled: “Advances in Condition Monitoring and Structural Health Monitoring - WCCM 2019”

The Proceedings will be published by Springer.

As the Editors of the Proceedings and together with the Local Organising Committee, we will do our best to help you to publish your manuscripts in the proceedings. We would be very grateful if you will read the following notes regarding manuscript review and checks:

1. Each manuscript will be peer-reviewed by two referees.
2. For manuscripts that will be accepted for publication, authors will need to provide the pdf files along with the source files.
3. If the text or illustrations that authors have incorporated in manuscripts are from other sources or from previous publications, authors will need to obtain the permissions for incorporation of these non-original materials. Incorporation of non-original excerpts without the necessary permissions could result in manuscript retractions.
4. All colour illustrations will be available in full colour in Springer eBook, but may be black and white in the printed book. If colour is essential for individual figures in the printed version, authors need to list the corresponding figures in a separate spreadsheet.
5. The Local Organising Committee will check all manuscripts for plagiarism (using iThenticate software) before submitting the manuscripts for review. The acceptable level of plagiarism is less than 15%. If the Committee identifies a non-acceptable level of plagiarism in a manuscript, the manuscript will be returned to authors for revisions.
6. We recommend that all authors to check their manuscripts for plagiarism before manuscript submission.
7. Springer will also check for plagiarism for all manuscripts that will be submitted for publication. If Springer identifies a non-acceptable level of plagiarism in a manuscript, Springer will return the manuscript for revisions.
8. Each corresponding author of the accepted manuscript should print the Consent form, enter the title of the manuscript, as well as the names of the authors at the top of the form and sign it. Details of the manuscript authors (sequence, names, and affiliation of corresponding author) given in the CTP should be complete, final and correspond to the details given in the manuscript. As this is a legal document, Springer cannot accept changes at a later stage.
